# Letter from Our Founders



Dear Friends,

As we prepare to enter our 15th year, we are filled with gratitude for the journey that has led Declare No More Foundation to where we are today. We launched with “2 quarters in our back pocket and a dream” and to see all God has done is truly humbling.

From the 100 or so people gathered with us at our launch to over 200,000 impacted. From our first awareness event to now over 70 events hosted across the nation. From our first anti-trafficking training to over 135,000 educated. From our first outreach to over 44 this year alone. From supporting survivors of human trafficking living in restoration homes to funding 5 homes in 4 counties.

The number of families, women, and children who have found freedom, hope, and healing is beyond what we ever could have imagined. But more than just looking back at where we've been, and celebrating where we find ourselves today - we hope this Impact Report will paint a picture of the future that is possible.

As an organization we dream about what it's going to take to provide long term, sustainable solutions that will transform our communities. To wrap around struggling families to keep them from falling apart. To ensure that no child ever must sleep in an office because there aren't enough foster homes. To make sure that no victim of human trafficking (adult or child) heads back out to the streets because there wasn't enough support available to help them recover from the atrocities they have endured.

We may not be able to solve all the world's problems, but we can get to work to help as many as we possibly can. And we remain vigilant in our commitment to see one million people moved to action to care for the vulnerable. We're well on our way, but there's so much more to be done.

It is the honor of our lives to lead this organization and serve alongside our incredible team and community partners. We look forward to what's ahead, standing in faith, believing that the best is yet to come.

## HTAE Radiant Church Odessa





At our May HTAE, seven attendees self-identified as survivors of HT, taking a brave step towards healing.

# Everyone Deserves To Be Found

Those words, simple and powerful, tug at my heart as I listen to the Declare No More Foundation Investigative Team recall the recovery efforts that rescued a young girl from the clutches of a human trafficker recently.

It had been 5 days when the first call came in. A girl. Age 15. Missing. Most likely a runaway.

She'd been in trouble before. Local law enforcement had been involved. Without much information to go on, the case had to wait. She'd probably come back home eventually.

Her mom was frantic and desperate. She had seen her daughter's behavior change. Her appearance changed. Her attitude changed. And then she was gone.



Even in the chaos of a struggling home life filled with job loss and homelessness, her mother knew something was off. Our lead investigator leaned in to help where a system couldn't.

Then it happened, success after 33 days. Mom finally had won the fight and gained access to her daughter's phone. Finally! She had access to messages, real proof that her daughter had been lured away by the darkness of this world.



So many red flags, how did she not know? Her unassuming daughter met a man. A stranger from out of state. Online. There were pictures, promises to love her, and plans to come meet her.

**This child walked out of her house to meet her “boyfriend” and ended up in the arms of her “trafficker”.**

The moment Declare No More's Investigative Team had the evidence needed to ignite action, we responded swiftly.

Calls were made to Homeland Security, local law enforcement, The FBI, and others. It took two weeks but working together we found her in a hotel over 1500 miles away. Finally... she was safe. Her trafficker was apprehended, and after 47 days of fearing the worst, her parents got the news: she was found and she was safe.

Hard pressed, our Recovery Team jumped into action with just 48 hours to reunite her with her parents or she would enter the foster care system far from home. Almost immediately, travel was arranged, her father and the Declare No More Foundation Recovery Team were on the ground. Once reunited, there were tears, and the long trip home, to healing, could begin.

Like so many trafficking victims, she was brainwashed. One of the recovery team members, who was a survivor herself, understood this situation all too well. Hearing this young girl say how much she loved her trafficker and that she wasn't a victim, our team member knew this girl just needed someone. To hear her. To see her. To care. She sat for hours, just listening. Eventually the girl relaxed and said, "It's just nice that somebody actually hears me. Someone hears what I'm saying." And in that moment, there was a breakthrough.

Our partners at Boomerang Air Charter met us to transport her home. Hours later we were back home and finally mom was within reach. The reunion felt like a scene out of a movie. A scene no one involved in this work ever forgets.

It was a miracle.

Our Recovery Team handed off her care to Child Protective Services, ensuring the family received desperately needed and specialized trauma-informed care, crisis counseling, and social services. In the weeks and months since, Declare No More's Investigation and Recovery Teams have stayed connected to everyone involved, doing our best to make sure this child never falls through the cracks again.



This is just one example of how Declare No More Foundation is involved in the fight against human trafficking by helping to fill a critical gap behind the scenes – coordinating logistics and aiding recoveries.

**In 2025 our Logistics Team received 98 leads, investigated 93, referred 8 cases to local and federal law enforcement for justice and recovery efforts, and 3 victims of human trafficking were successfully returned home.**

### Jim




